Driven by this understanding, the Mission of KMS is to Advance Advanced Technologies in following two ways:

- Advancing the technologies / systems themselves, and
- Advancing the technologies / systems through the applicable acquisition process and/or through the next acquisition milestone.



KMS will be the Prime contractor for all Seaport Task executions.
